MINUTES OF THE 31st ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING NUTRITION SOCIETY OF MALAYSIA

Date: Friday, 25 March 2016 Time: 5.15 pm – 7.45 pm

Venue: Bunga Room Seri Pacific Hotel, Kuala Lumpur

1. Welcome address by the President

Dr Tee E Siong, NSM President, welcomed members to the 31st Annual General Meeting. Dr Tee conveyed his sincere appreciation to members for their presence and called the meeting to order at 5.15pm.

Dr Tee thanked all the members and council members for their continued support for the activities of NSM. Dr Tee briefed the members on the agenda of the AGM. As he was not present for past meeting, therefore, Dr Tee invited Emeritus Prof Dr Mohd Ismail, Vice President to bring members through the previous AGM minutes as Prof Ismail chaired the past AGM. Dr Tee informed the members that Nutrition Division (Bhgn Pemakanan) of MOH have a new Director, Pn Zalma Abdul Razak. On behalf of NSM Council, he congratulated her and emphasised that NSM will continue to work together with Nutrition Division.

2. Minutes of the 30th AGM

- 2.1 The Vice President, Emeritus Prof Dr Mohd Ismail brought the members through the minutes of the 30th AGM that was held on 27 March 2015 at the Bunga Room, Seri Pacific Hotel, Kuala Lumpur.
- 2.2 The minutes of the 30th AGM were adopted on the proposal of Assoc Prof Dr Hamid Jan Jan Mohamed (L 0776) and seconded by Dr Zawiah (L 0017) with no amendment.

2.3 Matters arising from the minutes

2.3.1 Proposed Amendment (Article 11 - d)

Emeritus Prof Dr Khor raised a question on Article 11(d), on why all the main office bearers namely President, Vice-President, Hon Treasurer or the Hon Secretary are authorised to approve expenditure of not exceeding RM5,000 for the management of Society. She was concerned that the clause maybe misused and unclear whether the amount is per transaction or otherwise. In reply to Prof Khor's query, Dr Tee responded that this statement has been tabled and obtained approval by members in previous AGM. If there is a need to amend the clause, it can be done in the next AGM. He also urged members to give input on this matter and any other issues on the amendment of NSM Rules.

3. NSM Council Report 2015

Prof Norimah expressed her sincere thanks to all Council Members especially Dr Tee, Prof Ismail and Dr A. Mahenderan for their assistance and support in preparing this report. Prof Norimah reminded the members to check our website for updates and if they do not receive any email to please notify the NSM Secretariat.

Prof Norimah briefed members on the various activities organized by NSM in 2015 which included the 9th APCCN conference, 30th Annual Scientific Conference, 13th Nutrition Month Malaysia events, publication of MJN and several collaborative projects with corporate bodies as highlighted in the Council Report. Prof Norimah also highlighted the members that in 2015, NSM had elected YBhg Datuk Dr. Lokman Hakim bin Sulaiman, Deputy Director – General of Health (Public Health), MOH as an Honorary Member of the Society.

3.1 Adoption of NSM Council Report 2015

The Council Report for year 2015 was adopted on the proposal of Dr Chin Yit Siew (L 1654) and seconded by Lalitha Palaniveloo (L 1306) with no amendments.

3.2 Matters arising from Council Report 2015

3.2.1 Malaysian Confederation of Allied Health Professional Associations (MyCHAP)

Datin Safiah queried regarding the MyCHAP. In response, Prof Ismail informed the meeting that this MyCHAP was formed to bring 23 allied health professions under one umbrella. The major activities of MyCHAP were to organise conferences in rotation among these professional bodies and for the record, NSM has organised a conference on Allied Health before the MyCHAP was formed.

3.2.2 NADI project

Assoc Prof Dr Hamid informed the members of meeting that the Council Report should include a project on diabetes that empowers women on healthy nutrition, where he is representing NSM in this project. Council will take note of it.

3.2.3 Malaysian Journal of Nutrition (MJN)

Emeritus Prof Dr Khor Geok Lin informed the meeting that MJN has been listed under MyCitation Centre (Ministry of Education) and MJN is one of the active journals in Malaysia. MJN has been receiving articles from many countries and almost 70% of articles are from outside Malaysia. The number of citation from MJN articles has been increasing over the years and reported an unofficial impact factor of 0.167. MJN is under Scopus-Scimago and our H-index is 10.

Prof Khor informed members that MJN needs to do online submission and register with Thomson Scholar-One. The fee for setting up the online submission and register with Thomson Scholar-One will be USD 5000 and separate chargers per manuscript. On behalf of Council and members, Dr Tee thank Prof Khor for her enormous contribution to the development and advancement of MJN.

3.2.4 Allied Health Act

Dr Tee informed the members the Act has been passed in December 2015 and NSM had taken an extra step to brief members during NSM Conference 2016. The Allied Health Division will have a session (Meeting the Experts) and members can get latest update on Act especially on the implementation.

4. Treasurer's Report 2015

- 4.1 Assoc Prof Dr Zaitun (L 0009), the Honorary Treasurer, expressed her sincere appreciation to NSM Honorary Auditors, namely Assoc Prof Dr S Vellayan (L 0226) and Assoc Prof Datin Dr Safiah Md Yusoff (L 0004) for endorsing the Treasurer's Report. Their comments and constructive suggestions have been taken into consideration to improve the Report.
- 4.2 Assoc Prof Dr Zaitun presented the Treasurer's Report for year 2015. She highlighted the major areas of income and expenditure of the Society for year 2015.

4.3 Matters arising from the Treasurer's Report 2015

- a) Prof Khor suggested that the conference's receipts and payments should be more detailed in the Treasurer's Report.
- b) Prof Khor also suggested that NSM should have engaged with professional assistance for preparing the accounts. She also proposed to have new position

in NSM Office Bearer's namely Asst Hon Treasurer. Council will consider the suggestion.

4.4 Adoption of Treasurer's Report 2015

The Treasurer's Report 2015, was proposed to be adopted by Pn Rohaida Saleh Hudin (L 1440) and seconded by Dr Razinah Sharif (L 1604).

5. NSM Fellows

Dr Tee informed the members that the Council has received 2 nominations and recommended both for member's deliberation. The nominated fellows are:

- 1. Assoc Prof Dr Hamid Jan Jan Mohamed (L 776) (USM)
- 2. Dr Mahenderan Appukutty (L 718) (UiTM)

The members unanimously accepted both nominations. The certificate will be given during NSM conference on 30 May 2016.

6. Election of 16th Council Members

Dr Tee thanked members of the 15th Council for their cooperation and support throughout the past two years. Dr Tee informed the members that Dr Tan Sue Yee could not continue to be NSM Council member due to her personal commitments. The Council thank her for her contribution and wished her all the best. He then formally dissolved the 15th NSM Council.

Prof Khor Geok Lin proposed a vote of thanks to the out-going Council Members for their services to NSM. Members of the meeting collectively elected Prof Khor as Chairperson for the Election of the 16th NSM Council.

A total of 119 ballot papers were received and these were counted in the presence of members. Several members assisted in the counting of votes.
