MINUTES OF THE 33rd ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING NUTRITION SOCIETY OF MALAYSIA

Date: Friday, 30 March 2018 Time: 4.00 pm – 7.35 pm

Venue: Baiduri Room, Hotel Istana, Kuala Lumpur

Total members present = 45 members & 5 observers (Appendix 1 – Attendance List)

1. Welcome address by the President

Dr Tee E Siong, President of NSM, called the meeting to order at 4.30 pm. He noted that there is sufficient quorum to proceed with the AGM. The President thank members for attending the 33rd Annual General Meeting of the Nutrition Society of Malaysia.

He informed members present that the main agenda items of this AGM would to receive a report of the activities of the NSM for the year 2017 and the financial summary of the Society. An important agenda is of course the election of the 17th Council of the NSM. He remarked that the NSM implemented many projects in the year that were geared towards achieving the 2 main objectives of NSM, namely 1. To promote nutrition science, and 2. To promote healthy nutrition amongst the community. Details of these will be contained in the annual report of the NSM Council. Most of these were implemented in collaboration with other professional societies as well as with the corporate companies.

With these introductory remarks, he proceed to address the 1st item on the agenda, ie the minutes of the 32 AGM of NSM. He invited Dr Mahenderan Appukutty, Hon Assistant Secretary of NSM to highlight the discussions during the AGM last year.

2. Minutes of the 31st AGM

2.1 The Asst Hon Secretary, Dr Mahenderan Appukutty brought the members through the minutes of the 32nd AGM that was held on 25 March 2016 at the Bunga Room, Seri Pacific Hotel, Kuala Lumpur.

2.1 The minutes of the 32nd AGM were adopted on the proposal of Mr Ng Chee Kai (L 1708) and seconded by Assoc Prof Dr Foo Leng Huat (L 1531) with no amendment.

2.2 Matters arising from the minutes

There was no matter arising from the AGM minutes for discussion.

3. NSM Council Report 2017

Dr Mahenderan Appukutty expressed his sincere thanks to all Council Members especially Dr Tee, Prof Ismail, Prof Norimah, Dr Zaitun, Dr Roseline, Dr Wong Jyh Eiin and Dr Hanis Mastura for their assistance and support in preparing this report. Dr Mahenderan has reminded the members to check NSM website for updates and if they did not receive any email to please notify the NSM Secretariat.

Dr Mahenderan briefed members on the various activities organized by NSM in 2017 that included 32nd Annual Scientific Conference, 16th Nutrition Month Malaysia activities, publication of MJN and several collaborative projects with corporate bodies as highlighted in the Council Report with 29 pages. One of the landmark development for the NSM activities in 2017 was successfully organising the 1st Southeast-Asia Public Health Nutrition Conference from 14 to 17 May 2017 and completing the first NSM Malaysia Nutrition Leadership Programme.

3.1 Adoption of NSM Council Report 2017

The Council Report for year 2017 was adopted on the proposal of Assoc Prof Datuk Dr Vellayan Subramaniam (L 0226) and seconded by Assoc Prof Rokiah Don (L 0023) with no amendments.

3.2 Matters arising from Council Report 2017

3.2.1 Malaysian Journal of Nutrition (MJN)

Dr Tee briefed the members on behalf of Emeritus Prof Dr Khor Geok Lin who was not able to attend the AGM. He informed the meeting that MJN has subscribed to the ScholarOne journal management system where submission and reviewing of all manuscripts is now being done through the online management system. Versacomm has been appointed by NSM Council to operate the system guided by Prof Dr Khor (Chief Editor of MJN) and Dr Tee (President of NSM). Response to the online system has been encouraging. Since launching the online system in February 2018, a total 54 manuscripts have been processed.

Dr Tee also mentioned to the members that NSM has created a dedicated email for MJN – mjneditor@nutriweb.org.my for all communication on MJN matters.

3.2.2 SEAPHN and 32nd NSM Scientific conference

Dr Tee informed the members that the first public health nutrition in the region was successfully organised by NSM on 15 to 17 May 2017 at the Istana Hotel. Dr Tee informed members that a total of 477 delegates from 23 countries participated. There were 12 symposia, 5 plenary lectures, 8 lunches symposia and free papers (oral and poster).

3.2.3 NSM Nutriweb

Dr Tee informed the members that the new website still not yet ready for public. The Council apologies for delaying launching the new website. However, Dr Tee promised that the new Nutriweb will be more attractive and user friendly.

3.2.4 Malaysian Nutrition Leadership Program (MyNLP)

Dr Tee informed the members that the MyNLP is an effort of NSM to groom younger nutritionists in Malaysia to be future leaders in nutrition. This initiative is inline with NPANM strategies to promote capacity building among nutritionists.

3.2.5 NPANM

Assoc Prof Rokiah enquired about stating the NSM involvement in the action plan of NPANM in the Council Report. In response, Dr Tee mentioned that last year Council Report has mentioned the significant contribution of NSM in the action of NPANM. Dr Tee also briefed the members of meeting that NPANM is the main reference (blueprint) for nutrition development in Malaysia and NSM actively participated in the development of NPANM since 2000.

3.2.6 NSM Representatives in various committees

Datuk Dr Vellayan suggested that instead of one NSM representative in various committees, it is better to have two representatives for continuity. Dr Tee explained that this is indeed the case for some committees. For example the TWG nutrition promotion of MOH, Drs Zaitun and Wong are representasives. Representation from NSM depends on the requirement/request of the committee.

3.2.7 Arkib Negara and National Library

Datuk Vellayan suggested to send the Council Report and also MJN and other NSM publications to Arkib Negara and National Library. Council will take note of this suggestion.

4. Treasurer's Report 2017

- 4.1 Dr Zaitun Yassin (L 0009), the Honorary Treasurer expressed her sincere appreciation to NSM Honorary Auditors, namely Assoc Prof Datin Dr Safiah Md Yusoff (L 0004) and Dr Gan Wan Ying (L 1795) for reviewing NSM accounts and endorsing the Treasurer's Report. Their comments and constructive suggestions have been taken into consideration to improve the report.
- 4.2 Assoc Prof Dr Zaitun presented the Treasurer's Report for year 2017. She highlighted the major areas of income and expenditure of the Society for year 2017.

4.3 Matters arising from the Treasurer's Report 2017

- a) Mr Ng Kim Keat proposed to have tax and account consultant for NSM financial report preparation. He enquired on using the term such as "transferred" that been used in the Receipts and Payments of NSM (transferred to SEA/PHN account) as this may cause confusion. In response, Dr Zaitun briefed the members of meeting that the fund transferred from main account of NSM to SEAPHN account due to fund deposited by the sponsors into main account of NSM which is actually meant for SEAPHN or NMM account. Dr Tee explained that companies usually register only one vendor, ie NSM main account and all monies are paid to thata account. In addition, He also mentioned that Council will discuss regarding appointing tax consultant or accountant to assist in preparing Treasurer's report.
- b) Mr Ng and Assoc Prof Datuk Dr Vellayan raised question on GST. Dr Zaitun responded that she has checked and was informed that NSM does not need to register for GST. Dr Tee suggested that NSM council will discuss with tax consultant on this matter again.
- c) Assoc Prof Datuk S. Vellayan suggest the financial report to have separate notes for various projects involving large amounts of money, with explanation on income and expenses (honorariums, secretariat fee and services). He also requested to list the fixed deposit with total amount and interest earned. Dr Zaitun mentioned that his point taken and will be done in next year. In response to fixed deposit (FD), Dr Tee responded that all FD details will be listed and securitized by the Hon Auditors. Datuk Vellayan agreed that will be sufficient and no need to be reflected in the financial statement.

4.4 Adoption of Treasurer's Report 2017

The Treasurer's Report 2017 was proposed to be adopted by Assoc Prof Datuk Dr Vellayan (L 0226) and seconded by Mr Ng Chee Kai (L 1708) with amendments:

5. Election of 17th Council Members

Dr Tee thanked members of the 16^{th} Council for their cooperation and support throughout the past two years. He then formally dissolved the 16^{th} NSM Council.

Dr Mohd Nasir Mohd Taib and Dr Hanis Mastura Yahya thanked all Council members and Dr Tee, for the teamwork and guidance throughout as Council Member of NSM. Both of them indicated that they are not able to continue as Council Members due to personal commitments and wished the next Council every success.

Datuk Dr Vellayan proposed a vote of thanks to out-going Council Members for their outstanding service to NSM. Members elected Mr Ng Kim Keat as Chairperson for the Election of the 17th NSM Council. Assoc Prof Dr Foo Leng Huat and Mr Chee Kai voluntarily assisted the Chair for the election process.

A total of 126 ballot papers were received and these were counted in the presence of members. Several members assisted in the counting of votes.
